**Chaminade Parish Scholarship**

Institutional scholarship awarded to new first-year students who are recommended by a Hawaii parish. Students must be nominated by their parish priest. This award is renewable for a maximum for 4 years provided the students maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0

Students should see their parish priest. If the student is deemed worthy of recommendation, the priest will complete a nomination form and write a letter of recommendation, which will be returned to Chaminade University. Generally, only one student per parish can be recommended, however, exceptions may be permitted.

Eligibility Requirements  
 Applicant must:

- 1) Be a United States citizen
- 2) Have graduated from high school with a cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.0
- 3) Be a new college student who has never attended another college/university
- 4) Be accepted into Chaminade as a regular full-time day-student
- 5) Be charged the maximum day-student tuition for the academic year
- 6) Nominated by their Hawaii parish priest based on their academic potential and involvement in school, church, and community
- 7) Complete 20 hours of community service per academic semester

**Award Amount:** This award is the value of one half of the full-time day tuition.  
**Deadline:** Nominations should be submitted prior to the start of the semester for which the student intends to enroll.
