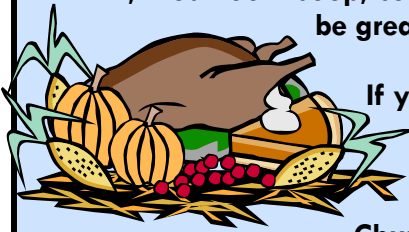

In his book, Deacon Gerakas explores how the Churches of the East and the West, who claim the same holy mother, prepare for, gather, and consume their heavenly bread. The biblical background and history of the Eucharist in the Orthodox and Catholic Churches and a comparison of current practices are covered as are some of the doctrinal and organizational differences that inhibit a return to intercommunion, the ultimate goal of both Churches in their desire to fulfill the Lord's Prayer "that all may be one."

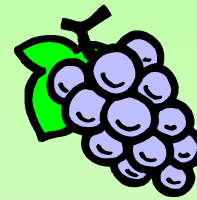

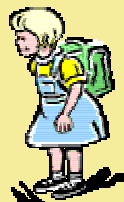
