Marriages

Appointments should be made with the priest at least 6 months before the proposed date of marriage. The Diocese of Honolulu requires a four- to six-month preparation period for marriages.

Funerals

Family of the deceased should contact the parish office and the mortuary of their choice so that plans may be made with mutual consultation.

Home Visits

Shut-ins living in the parish and wishing to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation, Anointing, and Communion should notify the parish office.

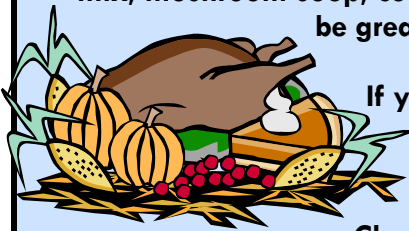
