## Feast of the Holy Trinity

Following Pentecost Sunday, the Feast of the Holy Trinity is an occasion for us to tell God: Thank you, we now know you, and we acknowledge you as our source of life, faith, and love. The Book of Genesis says that we live because the spirit of God is within us.

The Spirit not only brings us to life, but also brings us together. In the Bible, being together is so important, that a person separated from his family, his neighbors, his community and church, is already dead. We cannot live without acknowledging and welcoming one another. Our spirit is not meant to exalt our personality or our ego. As a matter of fact, the spirit is not to be kept within but to be given.

When Jesus speaks about his Father, he doesn't talk about a distant Father, or a solitary God. The relationship between Jesus and God was so personal, so unique, that the disciples saw through Jesus, a kind of love that is not related to our feelings but to our spirit.

When Jesus commanded his disciples to: "Go and make disciples of all nations," He told them: "Baptize them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Why? Because the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are and work, together, in communion of life and love.

Sometimes we may mistake God with one almighty ego, with one almighty will; whose ego or will is above everything. But this God is not the Father or Jesus. Why? Because true and lasting joy only comes to us when life blossoms around us and within us. And life only blossoms when we give ourselves to one another, sharing on earth the communion of life and love that the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit share in heaven.

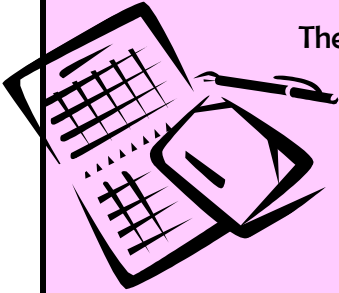

Therefore, relatives or friends of the patient should visit the "admission office" as soon as possible during business hours and inquire whether the patient is listed as Catholic and mention that a priest's visit is requested. Informing a doctor, nurse, nurse's aide, ward clerk, and admission clerk at the time of admission is no guarantee that the patient is listed as "Catholic" due to stress, lack of time, and eagerness to treat the patient then. Go to the admission office to insure the listing.

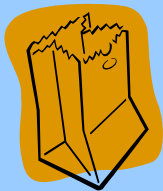
June is Home Safety Month...Install smoke alarms on every level of your home and in or near all bedrooms. Test the batteries at least once a month so you'll know they are working.
